What's a Dame to do?

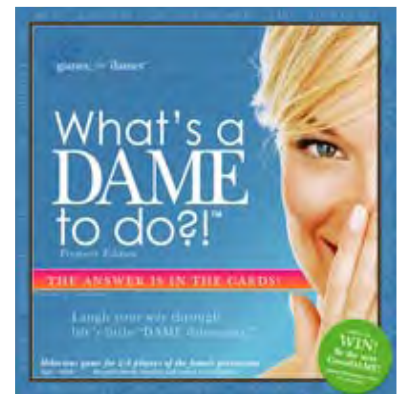
